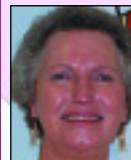

My wife and I were playing in the local sectional tournament, and mid-way through the first session, we arrived at the table of Mr. and Mrs. Axel P. Bushrod (the names have been changed to protect the guilty). The Bushrods are familiar opponents, they play at our club. They can be described, perhaps charitably, as average players. Their bidding and play are so erratic, however, that they occasionally achieve extraordinary results. On this particular hand, the bidding proceeded normally enough.

Mrs. Bushrod was on lead. A double-dummy defender would have led the Ace of Diamonds, and the defense would have collected the first eight tricks. An ordinary player, such as myself, would probably have led the Queen of Diamonds, immediately killing the defense's prospects. Mrs. Bushrod may be an average player, but she is definitely not an ordinary one, so she led the Ten of Spades. Dummy came down and I decided that we would get a good score if the Bushrods did not find their Diamond before I got the lead.

Mr. Bushrod won the first trick with the King, and, evidently deciding that Spades held no future, looked for new worlds to conquer. Anyone else might have tried to drive the Ace of Clubs off the board, but Mr. Bushrod found the spectacular lead of the King of Diamonds!

This was a true newspaper play, and richly deserved the cold top that it earned. I was sitting at the table, and I still can't believe that I actually saw this fine play. Usually we just read about them in the bridge column. Unfortunately for the Bushrods, earning a top and cashing it in are two entirely different things. Mrs. Bushrod, no doubt pleased that her husband had found the Diamond shift, played low! Incredibly, with six diamonds in her hand, and six more laying face up on the table, she sabotaged his brilliant play, and completely cut off her own hand from the rest of the play. Of course, I was still oblivious to the true situation in Diamonds, and was merely disappointed that they had found their Diamond, and we were not going to get a good score on this board.

Mr. Bushrod, now out of Diamonds, and having used up all of his inspira-

tion, led a low Spade to the third trick. I was pleased to see him shift back to a Spades, but not really surprised, giving up tricks is standard Bushrod defensive technique. Feeling good that our fortunes had suddenly improved, I played the Nine of Spades, and Mrs. Bushrod followed suit with her low Spade – the Jack! I couldn't believe my eyes, the Jack absolutely had to be in Mr. Bushrod's hand. In fact, even now, as I'm proofreading this, I check the hand diagram, and sure enough, there is the Jack of Spades, in Mr. Bushrod's hand. But no, at the table, I was looking at it laying face up in front of Mrs. Bushrod. I could swear that Jack was actually grinning at me. Then my amazement turned to absolute horror, as she proceeded to cash five more Diamond winners, for down two. While I was dejectedly discarding on all of those Diamonds, I was thinking that if I had just played the Queen of Spades, I would have won at least eight tricks. As the dust from this disaster settled, the Bushrods smiled at each other, satisfied with their solid defensive effort, and, as an extra bonus, pleased that they had been able to show the Page's that they also knew a thing or two about playing bridge.

Still dazed, I congratulated them on their play of the hand. What else could I say, we'd just been Bushrodded again!

*Author's note: This is not a made-up hand, it actually happened. I don't know what all of the spots were, and the Clubs and Hearts may not have been divided between the defenders quite as shown, but the play of the Diamonds and Spades was exactly as described. The defenders' thoughts have been inferred, but I remember mine very clearly.*

# PRESIDENTIAL PROFILE

Judy Schorner of Vero Beach is the new president of Unit 240. Her husband, Jim, serves as treasurer for Unit 240. Both of them are long-time members of the Vero Beach Duplicate Bridge Club where Jim serves as the club's webmaster and legal advisor.

Judy was born in Paris, Kentucky, where her family was involved in tobacco farming. When she was a teenager, her family moved to Lexington, Kentucky, where she went to high school and the University of Kentucky. She initially studied radiology but later switched her major to accounting.

Accounting has come in handy for Judy who has spent most of her life fundraising. She was a Kentucky fundraiser for Special Olympics; a Kentucky Educational TV board member; and a former national and international board member of Mission Possible, finding sponsors for children in Haiti. The state of Kentucky honored her for her volunteer work by making her an Honorary Kentucky Colonel and an Honorary Kentucky Treasurer.

In January 2005 and 2006, Judy ran the Disney Marathon raising \$12,000 and \$29,000 respectively for the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society for cancer research. She also raised funds for the local Alzheimer/Parkinson Association for their Walk to Remember and for the Care Net Pregnancy Center.

If that is not enough, while working as a volunteer in the Emergency Department at Indian River Medical Center, Judy organized and directed bridge charity games for two years. She worked with the Emergency

Department staff to raise money for the new Emergency Department.

Judy is the director of Disaster Relief for her church; she sings in the church choir, sings on the praise team and is in her 7th year of Bible Study Fellowship, a seven-year program.

All of this is rather remarkable considering that Judy spent three years in a wheelchair back in the early 1990s and had to give up her accounting business. Doctors at the Cleveland Clinic in Ft. Lauderdale told her that she would never walk again. The condition caused her to lose five years of memory and her ability to concentrate. Therefore, she started taking bridge lessons to help her concentrate and she set a goal to become a Life Master, which she reached in three years. She has since become a bridge director and teacher.

In 2006, along with Jim, she was appointed as a lifetime member of the District 9 Goodwill Committee.

Speaking of Jim, Judy says he swept her off her feet on a blind date through friends at church. Although Judy never thought she would marry, Jim prevailed and the Schorners celebrated their 22nd anniversary on September 1st.

Judy enjoys traveling with Jim, gardening, reading, and, of course, playing bridge.

Judy has a son, Rob, who is a civil engineer in Kentucky and a daughter, Lisa, who is a 3rd grade teacher in Vero Beach. The Schorners have four grandchildren, a boy and a girl from each of the two families.

The Vero Beach Bridge Club is proud to claim Judy as one of its outstanding members.



# NEW SWISS TEAM FORMAT: EIGHT IS ENOUGH

While at the Chicago Summer Nationals, I attended a workshop for club owners/directors. I learned about a new Swiss Team format which was tried out in Memphis. It sounded so interesting, I thought it would be worth trying at our club. It is a great way of getting the inexperienced players to get used to playing with and against the life masters and it is called "Eight is Enough."

The formula is based on a number--3, 2, or 1 being assigned to each member of the team with the total of the 4 players adding up to no more than 8.

On Friday afternoons at Orlando Metropolitan Bridge Center, Millie and Rick Larkin run an open game at the same time I run a non-life master (0 - 299) game. We decided to combine our two groups and try out the new idea.

We chose a Friday in October and made it a Club Appreciation Swiss Team which pays gold points. We served a light lunch of sandwiches, salad, and dessert. We asked for reservations and teams were either formed by the players or with our help. Some of the non-life masters wanted to play with more experienced teammates and some wanted to play within their own ranks. We had 25 teams participate. It was so successful we are planning to repeat it next October.

Our formula was based on: 0 - 500 mps = 1, 501 - 1500 = 2, and 1501 plus = 3. Your formula can be based on your masterpoint field. As long as the 4 members of the team do not add up to more than 8, the team is eligible.

With 25 teams participating, and stratifying according to team totals, we had 8 A teams, 9 B teams, and 8 C teams. First place in A paid 5.83 masterpoints. This was won by a B team. First place

in C paid 2.40 masterpoints. A fraction of gold was paid to all overall winners. We call it "gold dust." For some, it was their very first gold and certainly sparked an interest in getting more "gold."

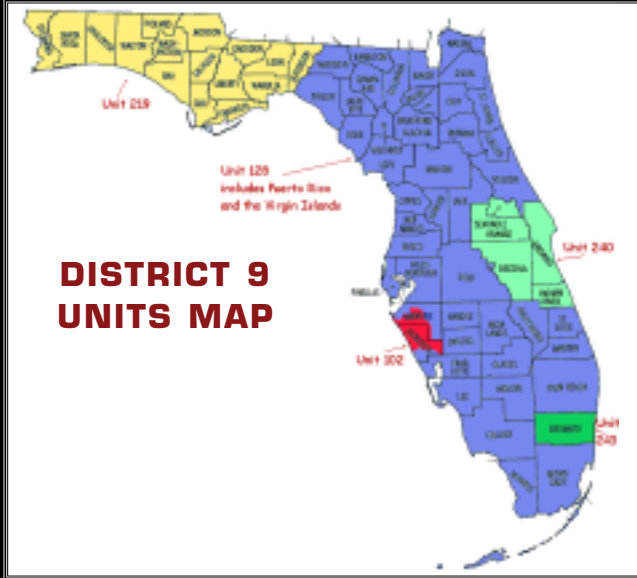
